Our Exhibits Committee will review all applications and notifications will be sent within 60 days of application submittal or by September 1, 2024. PLEASE DO NOT INCLUDE PAYMENT AT THIS TIME.

Ethnic Expo is an exciting festival. In 2023, we had thousands of wonderful people join us for a successful weekend of culture, food and entertainment. Ethnic Expo will begin Friday, October 11 at 11:00 a.m. and end Saturday evening, October 12 at 10 p.m. We are certain this will allow you a very profitable weekend! Food booths will be open from Friday at 11:00 a.m. through Saturday evening, as well.

As you know, Ethnic Expo has established itself as having an outstanding festival for both vendors and attendees alike. Many people attending always comment on the authenticity of the entire event. I would like to emphasize that the food items sold in your booths must be authentic. We encourage creativity with your menu to avoid duplication with other food vendors.

Booth space will be assigned at the discretion of the Exhibits Committee. Please return your application and indemnification agreement.

It is important that at least one person in your booth be in complete native dress at all times and it is suggested that everyone working in your booth wear a visible article/articles to represent your respective country, i.e. hat, sash, scarf, suspenders, etc. Interaction with the crowd is also encouraged.

We require all booths to be set-up by 10:00 a.m. Friday morning, October 11, 2024.

Political, religious, or commercial displays and/or advertisements are not allowed.

Ethnic Expo has made a commitment to become a sustainable event. We are taking steps to reduce waste, especially food waste, with recycling, composting, and education. We ask for your cooperation and support of this goal.
